THE APPELLATION

Created in 1999 and at Vinexpo, the wine "Portes de la Méditerranée" is a young name. It becomes the wine of "Mediterranean countries" in 2007 to evolve into "Mediterranean Protected Geographical Indication" in 2009. It is definitively recognized by the European Community on 1 January 2015. This regional PGI covers 10 departments in the South East of France.

VINIFICATION

The grapes are harvested by hand and are then destemmed and sorted out. After a cold maceration (24 hours), 1/3 of the volume is aged in barrels during 4 months.

TASTING NOTE

A shiny robe, light yellow color with silver shades. A delicate but yet intense aromatic profile with grapefruit, pear, floral notes and mineral flavors. The mouth is balanced with a final note on citrus, little white fruits
