## THE APPELLATION

The AOC Palette is the smallest and the oldest appellation of Provence. It was born in 1948 and it counts only 42 hectares. The appellation is composed of various Provencal grapes which are respected and preserved. The harvests are manual. This microappellation is at the gates of Aix-en-Provence.

Its soil is made of « Calcaire de Langesse » which is directly derived from the Sainte-Victoire mountain massif.

### VINIFICATION

The grapes are harvested manually. The wine is produced by static draining from our red wine vats. 80% of the volume matures in stainless steel vats and the rest in barrels for 8 months. Estate bottled.

### TASTING NOTE

A shiny color with peach shades and silver-grey shimmer. Delicate and complex nose with spicy notes, exotic aromas, lightly lemony with a fragrance reminiscent of roses. The mouth is ample, fresh. Long and harmonious finish.
