THE APPELLATION

Created in 1999 and at Vinexpo, the wine "Portes de la Méditerranée" is a young name. It becomes the wine of "Mediterranean countries" in 2007 to evolve into "Mediterranean Protected Geographical Indication" in 2009. It is definitively recognized by the European Community on 1 January 2015. This regional PGI covers 10 departments in the South East of France.

VINIFICATION

This wine is from a northern exposure plots which benefits from slow and soft maturities. The grapes have been harvested mechanically in September. After a cold maceration (3 to 4 hours) and/or a pressing, the fermentation is made at low temperatures. Estate Bottled

TASTING NOTE

A lychee robe with silver shades. The nose is delicate and complex with a palette of aromas: fresh spices, pepper, redcurrant, cherry and blackcurrant. Mouthfeel is balanced with gourmet final, close to red fruits with a pinch of pepper and cherry pit.
