THE APPELLATION

Created in 1999 at Vinexpo, the wine "Portes de la Méditerranée" is a young appellation. It becomes the wine of "Mediterranean countries" in 2007 to evolve into "Mediterranean Protected Geographical Indication" in 2009. It is definitively recognized by the European Community on 1 January 2015.

This regional PGI covers 10 departments in the South East of France.

VINIFICATION

The grapes have been harvested mechanically in September. The pressing is carried after a cold pellicular maceration of 24 hours. The fermentation and the aging are doing in thermo regulated stainless vats and 5% of the volume is aged in barrels during 4 months before blending.

TASTING NOTE

The color, clear and green, is tinted with gray reflections.

The nose, delicate, with a beautiful intensity, has white fruits, pear and citrus fruits' aromas.

The tasting, invigorating, under a frame of lemon, evolves towards notes of pineapple, leaving a chiseled, rich and smooth finish.
