THE APPELLATION

The Palette AOC is the smallest appellation in Provence and one of the oldest. Established in 1948, it encompasses merely 51 hectares distributed among a limited number of producers. It is characterized by the abundance of its preserved ancient Provençal grape varieties and by its soils derived from the "Calcaire de Langesse," which originates from the rocky barrier of the Sainte-Victoire mountain, located near Aix-en-Provence.
