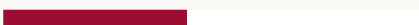
THE APPELLATION

Established in 1999 as Vin de Pays des Portes de la Méditerranée, this designation was renamed Vin de Pays de Méditerranée in 2007 and then IGP Méditerranée in 2009. Officially recognized by the European Union on January 1, 2015, this regional IGP currently encompasses 10 departments in the South-East of France.

Fermentation occurs in stainless steel tanks that are maintained at controlled temperatures.
